At Allied Printing Services, sustainability has been central to our business for decades. We continue to invest in energy-efficient systems and renewable energy sources that reduce our environmental impact while supporting the high-quality printing solutions our clients deserve.

- **On-Site Energy Generation:**
 - 1.4-megawatt Solar Array (4,540 solar panels)
 - 0.7-megawatt Fuel Cell
 - Together, these systems allow us to generate 75% of the electricity we use on-site.
- **LED Conversion: All lighting upgraded to energy-efficient LED**
- **Efficiency Audits & Inspections:**
 - Compressed air audits to identify savings opportunities.
 - Infrared electrical component inspections to ensure peak efficiency.
- **Recycling nearly 100% of consumables (cardboard, plastics, laminated paper, aluminum, virgin white and mixed paper)**
- **Employee focused recycling programs for paper, glass, plastic bottles and cans**
- **Vegetable & soy-based inks**
